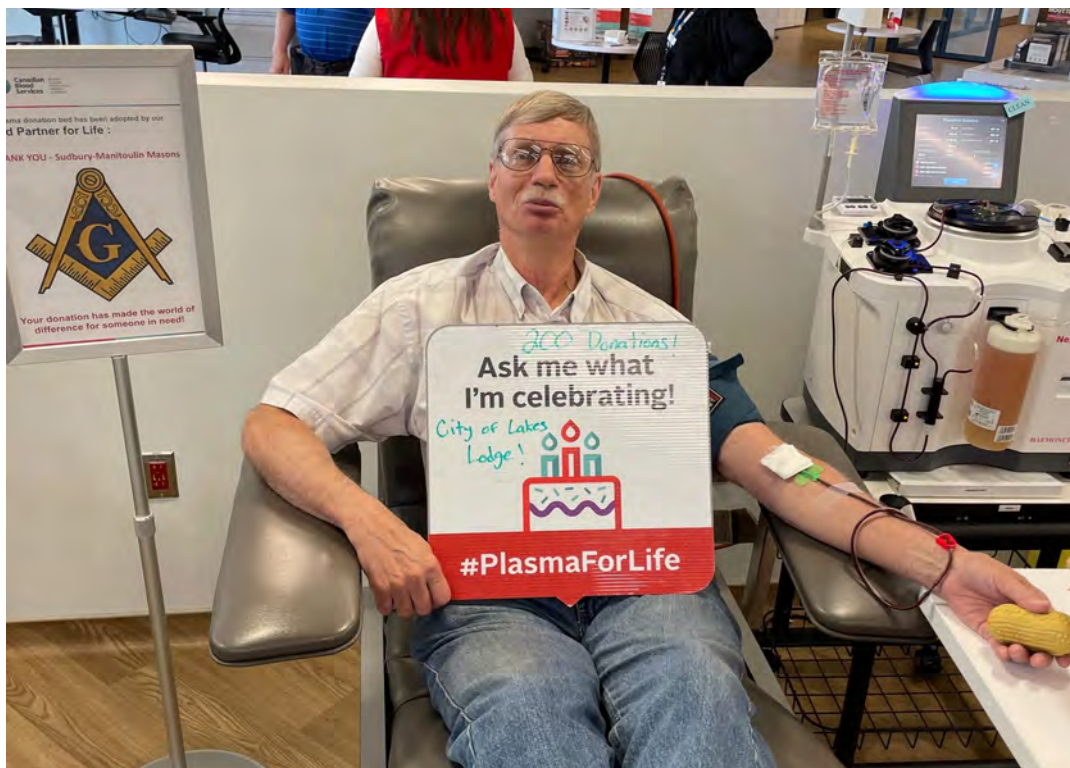


Plasma Donors Corner

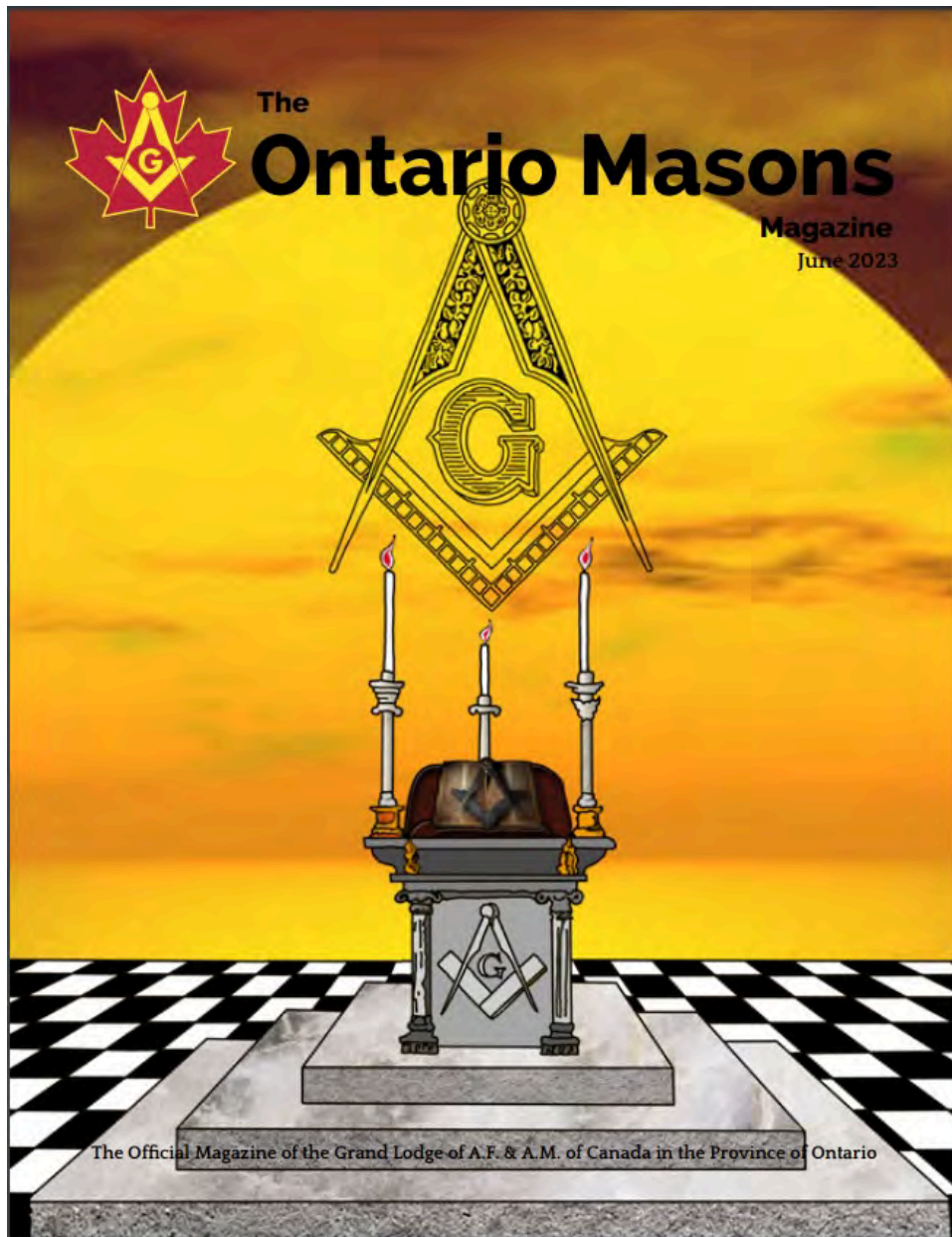
